A discussion followed in which it was noted that there was overwhelming consensus on the need to have a greater focus on oral language. The purpose and features of Learning Outcomes in a junior cycle specification	Following the presentation at the last meeting by Dr Anna Walshe, Denise Kelly reminded the group of Anna's key messages and added some further information on the purpose and characteristics of learning outcomes.
Critique of draft strands, elements and learning outcomes for Junior Cycle MFL	The group was divided in three and asked to consider the draft strands, elements and learning outcomes (LOs) for Junior Cycle MFL sent to everyone in advance of the meeting. They were asked to thoroughly critique the LOs using the information provided on the purpose and features of learning outcomes. Members were also asked to add their own comments. These were collated and passed to NCCA for consideration.
